Residential customers who install solar and are interconnected by 02-29-2022 will be grandfathered in to NEM2 utility rate plan for 20 years. NEM3 may go into effect as early as February, 2022 or be delayed until June, 2022. 10-year savings is based on levelized cost of energy. Assumes 5% annual cost of energy increase.
